

## Exhibition Mies van der Rohe award 2015 European Union prize for contemporary architecture

After a show in Barcelona, the results of the Mies van der Rohe award 2015, European Union prize for contemporary architecture' are exhibited at BOZAR. A critical look at contemporary European architecture is given in a visual and audible tour of the best 40 works built in the last two years.

The 'European Union prize for contemporary architecture / Mies van der Rohe award 2015' is an opportunity for the European Commission and Fundació Mies van der Rohe to pay tribute to the crème de la crème of contemporary, European architecture. Rem Koolhaas and Zaha Hadid are previous winners of this prestigious award. With scale models, drafts, photos and videos, the exhibition in BOZAR focuses on 40 designs which contribute to the character of Europe.

The spotlights will be specially put on the five finalists, the winner and the Emerging Architect Prize Winner:

- **Ravensburg Art Museum**, Germany, by Lederer Ragnarsdóttir Oei
- **Danish Maritime Museum** in Helsingør, Denmark by BIG - Bjarke Ingels Group
- **Antinori Winery** in Bargino-San Casciano Val di Pesa, Florence, Italy, by Archea Associati
- **Szczecin Philharmonic Hall**, Poland by Barozzi/Veiga
- **Saw Swee Hock Student Centre - London School of Economics**, in London, United Kingdom, by O'Donnell + Tuomey.

**The Szczecin Philharmonic Hall** became the **Winner** of the 2015 edition while the Emerging Architect Prize was awarded to the Catalan studio **ARQUITECTURA-G** for their work **Luz House**.

Before the exhibition opens an event will take place in a format of TED-talks followed by debates on 'Shaping European cities - How can policy makers and architects make cities more attractive?'
