In the same way, our entity has adopted the following Responsible Tourism Policy, by which it commits to comply with the requirements set out in the BIOSPHERE adhesion, which includes, among other things, the legal requirements that regulate the effects generated by touristic activity.

We are also committed to motivate and train our staff with training and awareness-raising activities on the principles of Responsible Tourism, to promote good environmental practices in the environment and to participate in external activities, and to report both internally and externally on the company's environmental progress and actions.

Similarly, our facility is expressly committed to combating sexual exploitation or any other form of commercial exploitation and harassment, in particular of children, adolescents, women and minorities; and we are committed to adopting universal accessibility measures.

One of our main objectives is to perfect sustainable management, committing to continuous improvement on all areas of sustainability: social, economic and environmental, as well as customer satisfaction. To this end, projects for future extension to facilities or activities will be subject to sustainability and efficiency in the use of resources criteria.

This Responsible Tourism Policy will be updated as circumstances require so, in both cases adopting and publishing new sustainability objectives.
