The Jury of the *4th Lilly Reich Grant for Equality in Architecture* awards the Grant to the proposal **“Transnational Narratives: A Documentary celebrating South Asian Women in Architecture”** submitted by **Dr Igea Troiani, Dr Mamuna Iqbal and Paula Roush.**

The jury members reviewed all the fifty-eight (58) proposals submitted to the *4th Lilly Reich Grant for Equality in Architecture* and met online on the 3 October 2024.

The stated reasons for the jury members to recognize this proposal are:

‘The proposal is relevant and highly topical given the inequality of women in this geographical context. The research focuses on a group of women in South Asia, far from the great architectural media spotlights. The idea of compiling and generating an oral and visual archive of the work of 6 women architects from Pakistan and India is the opportunity to show these professionals who may not have a place in any other forum. Unknown references will be shown to the general public. The research team demonstrates solvency in this field and knows the work of these women architects. The documentary and the archive generated are very relevant results as knowledge transfer. This proposal seeks the opportunity to show research that goes beyond the study of an individual figure.’
